

nated by acclamation and the nomination shall be reduced to two by ballot at a meeting held by this class at the request of the President of the Students' Association; and elected at a meeting held by this class a week later.

c. The names of the members thus elected shall be submitted to the Students' Association for ratification.

d. Any vacancy which may arise from the resignation of any member of the committee shall be filled by a member of the class to which the resigning member belongs, the election and ratification of this member to be made in the manner described in Article III, Section I, b and c.

Section 2. Duties and Powers.

a. Executive.

(1) It shall be the duty of the Self-Government Committee to enforce the rules of the Association and to consider business of that body.

(2) It shall be the duty of the existing Self-Government Committee to divide the residence halls and off-campus cottages into districts, and to determine the tenure of office of the prefects.

(3) It shall be the duty of the President of each Hall to call and preside at all meetings of her Hall, these meetings to be called at her discretion or at the written request of any five members of the Association resident in that Hall: to maintain order and decorum in her Hall with the assistance of the prefects in that Hall, and to perform all other duties pertaining to the office of the President of the Hall.

b. Judicial.

(1) The President of the Association, as Chairman of the Self-Government Committee, may at her discretion summon before her any member of the Association.

(2) The President of any Hall, as a member of the Self-Government Committee, may at her discretion summon before her any member of the Association resident in her Hall.
