

CONSTITUTION.

Article I.

Name.

The name of this organization shall be the Students' Association of Vassar College.

Article II.

Object.

The object of this Association shall be to enact and enforce laws in accordance with the charter granted to the Association by the Faculty of Vassar College, to transact business pertaining to the whole body of students, and to further the interests of the students so far as it lies within its power.

Article III.

Members.

All undergraduates of Vassar College may become members of the Association upon reading and signing its Constitution and By-laws. All graduate students and all alumnae, except those who are Faculty of the College, may be associate members, having power of discussion but not of voting.

Article IV.

Legislative Department.

The legislative power shall be vested in the Association as a whole.

Article V.

Executive Department.

The general executive power shall be vested in the officers of the Association who shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer, and in a Self-Government Committee.

Article VI.

Judicial Department.

The judicial power shall be vested in the Self-Government Committee.

Article VII.

Meetings.

Sec. 1. Annual Meetings.

There shall be four annual meetings.

a. A meeting shall be held as soon as possible after the beginning of the college year, at which meeting the President of the Association shall explain the purpose and organization of the Association.

b. Two meetings shall be held early in the spring for the nomination and election of officers for the ensuing year. A meeting shall be held later in the spring for the presentation of the gavel to the incoming President. The
