

PETITION

RESOLVED, that the Students Association petition the proper authority:

- I That tables of 10, or 9 and a guest, among the three upper classes stand as at present.
- II That those who do not form such a group be allowed to sit at tables not otherwise assigned.
- III That a system of rotation at meals, among all Freshmen in each hall, be adopted.
- IV That provisions I, II and III be put into the hands of a committee composed of students, and chosen at the discretion of the self government committee, for execution.

SUGGESTIONS FROM INVESTIGATING COMMITTEE.

- I That the following suggestions for placing the Freshmen at tables be tried for one year.
 - (A) In all cases where this is possible, Freshmen sit at all-Freshmen tables.
 - (B) Less than ten remaining shall be assigned to Senior, Junior and Sophomore tables in order of application, by groups composed of members of these classes.

Such an upper-classman table, completed by Freshmen, shall be considered a full table under I (of petition).
 - (C) Should there be no such applications, the remaining Freshmen shall be given any otherwise unassigned table.

The unoccupied seats at such a table may be used by students provided for by II (of petition).
