

THE VASSAR MISCELLANY.

By a vote of the Students' Association at a meeting held May 16, it was decided to raise the price of THE VASSAR MISCELLANY to \$2.00 per annum. This change will take effect on the expiration of present subscriptions. The reason for this alteration in price is that the increased expense of issuing the MISCELLANY in its present form necessitates a larger income for its adequate support. When published as a quarterly, the MISCELLANY gave about 270 pages of reading matter at \$1.20. As a monthly magazine, it averages about 550 pages of reading matter at \$2.00.

Most of the articles are written by undergraduates, thus making the magazine a good exponent of the average literary culture of the College. There are frequent contributions from members of the Faculty and Alumnae. In "Home Matters," college topics are thoroughly discussed. Special effort is put forth in collecting items of interest to Alumnae and former students.
