First, let me whistle in your ear that I am in the 3d Hall Play! It all happened Saturday. I had tried for three parts and been stung, so I had given up hope. Saturday noon Charlotte Gailor -- Chairman -- came over and asked to try for one of the minor men's parts -- a curate. So I went on the Granddaughters sleigh-ride and then ate one waffle at Carey's and tore for the Gym to try. After two trials we all trotted home and nothing happened till about 9 that evening when in [waltzes] Charlotte with the books, and told me I had

"made " my part. I am much delighted even if it is quite a small part, for it is fun to be in it at all.
