Biographical Note

Ida Treat was born in Joliet, Illinois, in 1899 and attended Western Reserve University. After earning a doctorate in letters at the University of Paris she returned in 1913 to Western Reserve, where she taught romance languages for the next seven years. In the 1920s she went back to France, where she lived as a writer and journalist for more than twenty years. While working as a correspondent for Paris Vu in the 1930s, she traveled throughout Europe, China, and the South Pacific. Her articles and stories appeared in United States periodicals such as *The Nation*, *The New Yorker*, *Harpers*, and *The Saturday Evening Post*. She was married three times, to Raymond O'Neil, Paul Vaillant-Couturier and André Bergeret. In her writing she used the name Ida Treat.

In 1948 Ida Treat Bergeret came to Vassar as Professor of English. She retired in 1954 after more than five years of teaching writing courses. When she died in 1978, her colleague and friend, Barbara Swain said that "she had freedom and adventure in a way that might make her a choice for a feminist model today. But she wouldn't like that very much. She was always too independent for playing roles."
