GEORGIA AVERY KENDRICK 1848 - 1922

The Faculty of Vassar College desires to record its sorrow at the death on December 14, 1922 of Georgia Avery Kendrick for twenty—two years (1891—1913) Lady Principal of Vassar College.

Occupying a difficult position where students and faculty meet on a more nearly equal footing she maintained dignity but not at the cost of affection and showed to all members of the College a warm feeling of personal interest. Gentle in manner, courteous in address and demeanor she revealed at the same time a steadfastness of purpose that endued her influence with unsuspected permanence and power. As social head of the College she embodied the grace of a hostess with a sincere knowledge of intellectual pursuits and respect for academic standards.
