To Capt. Parrish Agent of the Six Nations:

Sir, I am requested by the Chiefs in council to inform you that they ... do their endeavor (as soon as it is in their power,) to make William Pintuck up to the lots of his mile but- they do not expect that they can do it, as soon as next Spring but will as soon it is in their power-- They wish you to know ... the matter and make this necessary arrangements to meet the circumstances of the caro. They hope for an answer if necessary from you.
